

DRESS REHEARSAL

Wednesday - May 1, 2024

Lynn City Hall Auditorium

Johnson Street Entrance (REAR DOOR)

Performing students and one parent/guardian only are allowed to enter through the Stage Door. Dress Rehearsal is not open for spectators except for the one parent or guardian. When standing on Johnson Street facing the side of City Hall, the Stage Door will be the door at the very rear of building to the right. The one parent will need a **Gray Dress Rehearsal ticket** to enter. This ticket will be in your **"Yellow Envelope / Recital Packet"**. This envelope will be handed to you beginning Tuesday April 23rd thru April 29th. Parents, please make a point to see me on one of these days or at picture days.

Students should come to Dress Rehearsal dressed in her/his first or only costume, tights, with dance shoes and accessories already on.

Students will be escorted by a faculty member, volunteer, or an older Company student to the balcony where they will have a reserved seat and will be always supervised. Do not send students with food or drinks on either night. Dressing room students may have a water bottle only. Please label EVERYTHING! Students who have multiple costumes, should come dressed in first costume to be performed, and bring other costumes in a clearly marked garment bag with full name and dance classes listed on the outside of garment bags (Large label/print please). **Example: SUZY JONES – THURSDAY 4, SATURDAY 12**

Students who have more than 1 costume, will have an assigned Dressing Room. Parents, please assist your student as you come through dressing area to find her room and drop garment bag in room. Parents will go directly to the main auditorium and students will be escorted to the balcony where they will sit with their class and working parent/volunteer.

***Parking lot on Johnson Street will be open to park when City Hall closes at 4pm**

The Dress Rehearsal will run in exact order of the recital. Students will be seated in the balcony with my working parents, friends, and/or family. This area will be off limits to anyone who is not performing or working our shows. Security and safety are my number one priority during the dress rehearsal and recital. Please be patient and follow all protocols to ensure a positive experience for us all. Your children can be picked up and released to the 1 parent during one of the designated "Intermissions" only or at the very end of the show only. This way the lights will come on and it is easier and safer for dismissals. No performing student is allowed in the main auditorium at any time. Once you pick up your child you must stay in lobby or exit the building. If you want to watch the entire show, please leave your children in balcony.

Please send only one parent to the balcony to pick up your child. Parents must present the **"White Pick-Up Ticket"** provided (will be in your yellow envelope). Anyone who does not have their ticket will have to wait until the end of the show for a faculty member or myself to recognize you as the guardian and then release your child to you. Again, following the protocols will ensure the safety of your child and allow the dismissal to be smooth. **YOU NEED THIS TICKET ON RECITAL NIGHT AS WELL. MAKE SURE YOU SAVE!**

*Please make sure all costumes, tights, shoes, and accessories are organized and retrieved when picking up your children. You need them for Friday's performance. Please check everything before you exit the building. Dressing areas can be very chaotic if not organized.

Parent's, please drop off your children at the Johnson Street Entrance at 5:15pm. Children will be escorted by a faculty member, volunteer, or an older student to the balcony where they will have a reserved seat and will be always supervised.

*Parents & Guests need to enter through the main auditorium doors only. **No performing student should enter through the front main doors, only through the Johnson Street entrance.** Please drop them off and then go to the front main doors to enter!

*Students who have Garment Bags (multiple costumes changes) must come into Dressing Room area and follow instructions on where to hang belongings. Students with multiple changes should bring a water bottle with them. Please be organized! Costumes, Tights, Shoes, & accessories in the bag!

*Please see the Recital Program order to know your child's costume order.

*The Recital is approximately two hours with two ten-minute intermissions.

*Please remember when your child is done performing and if you would like to leave, you can only dismiss during a designated "Intermission" or at the very end of the show.

One Guardian/Parent only should come to balcony area and present the **"White Pick-Up Ticket"** to retrieve their child! Again, this is for the safety of your child. Please be patient and courteous to all my working parents and volunteers. They have instructions from me and are following them.

*Older students and Junior/Senior Company members, please clean up after yourselves in the dressing room areas.

*Students who are in the last section of our recital will take longer to get to the balcony to be released.

* There are NO flash Cameras/Phones or Videotaping allowed at any time during the recital. Please inform your family and guests so they are not called out and embarrassed. Flashes are dangerous to the dancers on stage and ruin the video. A professional videographer is filming the entire production (A Digital Download of the Recital will be emailed to all families two weeks after our show.). Sit back, relax, and enjoy it all! Your children and our staff have worked so hard! Please enjoy them!

*No Balloons are allowed in the auditorium at anytime! Don't forget to pick up your flowers in the lobby for your favorite dancer!
