### **REGISTRATION FEE**

\$35.00 per student due upon registering/ 3rd child No Reg Fee!

Annual due September 1, 2026, minus 10% if paying in full

## **HIP HOP**

**Shoes:** \*Hip-Hop sneakers – no brand required. **MUST BE** solid black high top, black laces, with white flat sole. \*Shop Walmart, Amazon, etc. \*On Your Toes does not carry this style.

**Attire:** Jazz/hip-hop pants or shorts (solid color) and fitted shirt

## **BALLET CLASSES** (Miss Lauren's Thursday Ballet classes only)

**Shoes:** Pink Ballet (**Bloch, split sole #258**)

**Shoes:** White Ballet (**So Danca #SD69**) & Leotard and tights any color.

# Dance Season 2026– 2027 Rules, Regulations & Dress Code

## SHOE REQUIREMENTS ON PREVIOUS PAGE

**KINDERDANCE - INTERMEDIATE CLASSES, JAZZ & TAP COMBO'S, ACRO, LYRICAL, COMPANIES, CONTEMPORARY:** Leotards/Dancewear, fitted dancewear of any color & Tan tights. Assigned Dance shoes (if required). Hair up and NO jewelry.

**BALLET CLASSES (Thursday classes only) :** Solid black leotard, Theatrical or Ballet pink tights and proper Ballet and/or Pointe Shoes. Hair must be up tight in a bun. **Hairnets are a must for all ballet students.** NO COLORED SPORT BRAS (Black Only)! NO PONYTAILS! NO JEWELRY!

**HIP HOP:** Solid black hip-hop sneaker with white sole, jazz/hip-hop pants or dance shorts and fitted shirt. Hair up and no jewelry. No Pajama bottoms!

**DANCE BAG:** All students should carry a dance bag to transport your properties (Dance shoes, dancewear, notebook, pencil, and hair supplies). Please write your name inside your Dance shoes and personal properties.

**ATTENDANCE:** Attendance is very important here at the Studio. Students must try to attend all of their scheduled classes. Choreography is always progressing and holds all other classmates back when the instructor spends class time re-teaching last week's lessons. Please be considerate to fellow classmates. Students who are too ill to participate, or have a conflict, please call or email to explain.

**COMPANY MEMBERS AND COMPETITORS:** You are not exempt from these rules; as a matter of fact, you have only *four* excused absences. Remember to use these only when needed. As the school year comes to the end there seems to be so many reasons why we need more time off so let's use them wisely!

**PLACEMENT:** All students are subject to change class level and time depending on their dance ability. Each student must be at her/his own level to learn and improve properly. All former students are subject to change class level and time depending on their personal growth. Level, Ability, Effort, Attendance, and Attitude will be taken into consideration for each and every student. **Attention! Company & Ballet Students!** Your level and class status may change. You will be notified (if needed) of your class/level change throughout the year at any given time.

**SNOW DAYS:** In the event of inclement weather, you will be notified by email. One snow day is included in the tuition; all other cancellations will have a scheduled make-up. **WE DO NOT ALWAYS FOLLOW THE LYNN PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM.** Our **Facebook** page will have all updated announcements and events.

**WAITING ROOMS:** We realize there are always exceptions, but one parent may accompany Kinderdance I & II level children. Because the waiting areas are small, we cannot allow the extra bodies. Waiting rooms will not be closed but we highly recommend dropping off and picking up your children. Bathrooms will be open for students, parents & staff only.

**TUITION:** Semester (3 Installments) – Pay on line by Debit or Credit through the “Studio Director Portal”.  
\*Payments in the form of Cash or Check may be mailed or dropped off to the dance studio prior to deadline.  
**\*Early Discount Deadline - September 1, 2026 – Pay in FULL and receive a 10% discount off your ANNUAL TUITION. (See your 3 semesters. Total them and deduct 10%. I will adjust on portal.**

**REFUNDS, LATE FEE'S & RETURNED CHECKS:** The Registration Fee is non-refundable. There will be no tuition refunds after November 1, 2026. \*A \$25.00 late fee will be charged **each month** for any tuition payments that are 2 weeks overdue. \*A \$30.00 fee will be charged for any checks that are returned for insufficient funds.

**There is NO food or drink allowed in the studio or waiting areas. Students may bring water only to class.**
